My Memories of the 'Filter' Plant and Sorgee's Café"***

Dr. Honeycutt, a 1956 graduate of Cliffside High School, was born in a house just north of the 'Filter' Plant on South Main Street. He attended Wake Forest University (then College), and Ohio State University. He then taught French Language and Literature at Ohio State from 1964 through 1970. From 1970 through 2000 he was at the University of Missouri, as Associate Professor and then Professor of French.

"The Early History of Cliffside Churches"

Dr. Bailey is also a graduate of Cliffside High School. He attended Wake Forest University (then College) and then Vanderbilt University. Dr. Bailey has held teaching appointments in Mathematics at East Carolina University in Greenville, NC, Cornell College in Mt. Vernon, IA and Trinity University in San Antonio, TX – from which he retired in 2001.
